New Business Documentation Requirements

Requirements for All Ownership Types

- 1 Each authorized signer must provide a valid **Driver's License or Government Issued photo ID** including their social security number.
- 2 A Federal Tax Payer ID (TIN) or Employer ID Number (EIN) as listed on IRS Form SS-4 (SSN allowed for Sole Proprietor).

Sole Proprietorship

√ Assumed Name Certificate

- If operating under an "assumed name."
- Must be filed in the county in which the sole proprietor is doing business.

Limited Liability Company (LLC)

- √ Certificate of Formation or Articles of Organization
- √ Company Agreement or Operating Agreement
 - Not applicable for Single Member LLC
- √ Assumed Name Certificate
 - If operating under an "assumed name."
 - Must be filed in the county in which the LLC is doing business.

Corporation

(profit or non-profit including C-Corp & S-Corp)

- √ Certificate of Formation or Articles of Organization
- ✓ Certificate of Authority from Texas-if formed in another state.
- √ Assumed Name Certificate
 - If operating under an "assumed name."
 - Must be filed in the county in which the corporation is doing business.

Partnerships

General

√ Assumed Name Certificate

- If operating under an "assumed name."
- Must be filed in the county in which the partnership is doing business.

Limited or Limited Liability

- ✓ Certificate of Formation or Certificate of Limited Partnership
- √ Assumed Name Certificate
 - If operating under an "assumed name."
 - Must be filed in the county in which the sole partnership is doing business.

Unincorporated Association

- ✓ Bylaws, Charter or Similar Document including meeting minutes to establish account.
- √ Assumed Name Certificate
 - If operating under an "assumed name."
 - Must be filed in the county in which the unincorporated association is doing business.
